Setting up a new live contest

- 1. Copy all files and folders *copy_live_contest* folder to the new contest folder (ie. mar-apr-2013).
- 2. Replace photo.jpg with the new jpeg.
- 3. Test it and you're done!

Note: The 'output' folder is where the submission text and image files are stored.

Converting to post contest version with answer keys

- 1. Make a local copy of the *copy_post_contest* folder and replace *photo.jpg* with current contest image.
- Edit index.html and answer-key-positions.css to update answer keys. When editing make sure you click on the div tag, ie <div.answer.one>. This will allow you to move the answers to their correct spot individually. (See comments in source code for guidance.)
- 3. DO NOT save any changes to the global.css file.
- 4. Rename *index.php* to *index_expired.php* and the *assets* folder to *assets_expired* in the current contest (the last issue) folder on the FTP server.
- 5. Upload new files*. The post contest index file is index.html do not rename it index.php.
- 6. Test it and you're done!

*It's not necessary to overwrite 'photo.jpg' when uploading.
